Culture and Education Society KIBLA is a coordinator of the multi-annual European cultural project Soft Control (oriented to the actualization of cultural phenomena that occur along the interconnection of art, science and public awareness), funded by the European Commission (EU Culture programme, [strand 1.1](#)). KIBLA has invited eight co-organizers from seven countries, to participate in this project - Slovenia, Serbia, Croatia, Latvia, Czech Republic, Portugal and Spain.

KIBLIX is part of the Project Soft Control and **invites you to the opening** of the international festival platform MFRU-KIBLIX2013: When worlds collide (art-science-technology), that will take place **on Wednesday, 6 th of November 2013 at 6 p.m** at [KIBLA PORTAL](#) on Valvasorjeva street 40, Maribor. At 8 p.m. the audio-visual performances starts. The name for the joint festival platform MFRU-KIBLIX2013: When Worlds Collide was inspired by the 1951 science fiction classic. The symbolism of the movie highlights the split and the paradox of the gap between the developed and the underdeveloped third world.

The MFRU-KIBLIX2013 includes interaction with various target audiences and encourages an active collaboration by everyone, especially young people, students and people with long-time professional experience... Culture and science intertwine as disciplines, constructively exchanging cultural models of critical thinking, activism and experimentation with scientific methods, research and knowledge. It symbolizes live nature, the reality which we live in, which is intertwined and dependent on the swift development of science, technology and consequently art and new forms of creativity.
